4 PRINCIPAL PARTS FOR BOYS

TINY TIM CRATCHIT

Small, thin boy - lame, walks with crutch. To look 9/10. Sad, resigned to his fate. Angelic looking. Audience to love him. To sing “Beautiful Day” very well. 10 lines of lib.

TURKEY BOY

Small, full of life, extrovert. One important scene in Act 2. Very cockney. No solo singing.

PETER CRATCHIT

To look 10/11. Only a couple of lines, but to act in all scenes with Cratchit family. No solo singing.

EBBY (Ebenezer Scrooge as a child)

Very appealing. To look about 8. Only a few lines. No solo singing.

3 PRINCIPAL PARTS FOR GIRLS

KATHY CRATCHIT

To look 11/12. Tiny Tim’s eldest sister. She looks after him. Nice & caring. 13 lines and 7 bars of solo singing.

JENNY SCROOGE

Scrooge’s older sister (the young version of Ghost of Christmas Past). To be very sweet & pretty. About 10. 7 lines of lib. No solo singing. Act 1 only.

MARTHA CRATCHIT

Youngest Cratchit child. To look about 8. Appealing. A few lines. No solo singing.
