WOMEN - 3 Major Parts

GHOST OF CHRISTMAS PAST

This is Jenny, Scrooge's older sister. To look late 60's. Very elegant lady. Takes Scrooge back in time to remind him how happy he was when he was young and the mistakes he made. In Act 1 only. No solo singing.

ISABEL

Fezziwig's daughter - To look in 20's - good singing voice needed. Beautiful, elegant, determined, emotional. Loves Scrooge, but wisely does not marry him because he obviously prefers money to her. A sad figure. In Act 1 only (**can be in Chorus in Act 2**). Sings "Happiness".

MRS CRATCHIT

Bob's wife. Early 30's. Nice, working class woman - slight cockney accent. Hard working - full of integrity. Strong character - critical of Scrooge. No solo singing. C25 lines of lib. Act 2 only. Can be in Chorus in Act 1.

6 Minor Parts (can also be in Chorus)

HELEN

Harry's wife. Late 20's. Very pleasant. A considerate hostess. Act 2 only. 10 bars solo singing in Act 2 Finale.

MARY

Buxom - in late 30's. Giddy, silly laugh - funny role. Leads Company in "Minister's Cat". No solo singing. 8 lines lib. Act 2 only.

MRS FEZZIWIG

Very jolly. Middle class lady in 60's. Bit dizzy - eccentric but loveable Dickensian character. Sings "December 25th" with Mr. Fezziwig.

MRS PRINGLE

Owns Toy Shop. No solo singing. 10 lines of lib. In both Acts. Any age.

MRS DILBER & MISS DILBER

Mother & daughter. Sellers of Shoddy - poor. 8 bars solo singing. Some lib. In both Acts.
